

DROUGHT UPDATE

STAGE 1



Stage 1 watering restrictions begin July 20.

What does Stage 1 mean?

- Outdoor irrigation is limited to 2 days per week.
- No watering between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Hand watering trees and shrubs is allowed if a hose is held and equipped with a shut-off device, but not between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.

2 Day Per Week Watering Schedule

| Single-family and small multi-family (less than 7 units) residential with odd-numbered addresses | Sunday & Wednesday |
| Single-family and small multi-family (less than 7 units) residential with even-numbered addresses | Saturday & Tuesday |
| Multi-family (7 or more units) and apartment properties | Monday & Thursday |
| Nonresidential customers | Tuesday & Friday |
| Properties managed for the sole enjoyment and recreation of the public, including parks and schools | Any day(s) of the week in compliance with the water budget |

Turf replacement is a great way to cut back water use.

A rebate of \$1 per square foot (\$1,000 maximum), is available for the removal of any high-water-use plant material and replacement with Xeric or drought tolerant vegetation.
